

## Caldwell Parish Church - Re-opening for worship

Please note that numbers for attendance are very restricted due to Government ruling so it will be necessary to book in advance. Please call **07341004728** to book.

### What to expect when arriving at church...

Please keep 2M distance from others at all times and:

- Wear a face mask or covering unless you have a health exemption.
- Sanitise your hands using the gel dispenser on the stand at the door.
- Place your offering in the bowl.
- In the vestibule you will be met by a steward and your contact details checked.
- You will move on to a steward at the left or right side aisles and shown to a seat.
- Please remain seated throughout the service and wear your mask.
- If you feel at all unwell or have a high temperature you will be asked to return home.
- As doors will remain open for ventilation and air circulation, **wear warm clothing.**
- Should you for any reason need to leave the Church early, exit by the side door.
- There will be toilet facilities available in the choir room only.
- At the end of the service remain seated until a steward comes to guide you to an exit.
- Do not congregate in groups once outside.

For communion, bring your own wine and bread. **Small paper cups will be provided.**

Bibles and hymn books have been removed, and there will be no signing during the service. Pew cushions have been removed as these are not suitable for cleaning. The hall, kitchen, porch toilet and other areas are not open at this time.

All high usage surfaces (such as handrails, door handles and toilets etc.) will be sanitised regularly in accordance with Government guidelines.

Your contact details will be retained per Scottish Government's Track and Trace guidelines.

It is hoped that despite all of the above detailed restrictions, we can at last enjoy the fellowship of worshipping together in our Church building.
